Streak Still Intact at Orlando Sanford

Sanford, Fla., June 27, 2001 – Total passenger traffic at Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) for May 2001 was up 5% over May 2000. This marks the 13th straight month of passenger increases over the same month the previous year. The Airport serviced more than 121,000 passengers in May, made up of 21,056 domestic travelers and 100,518 international. Although international traffic for the month was level, the inauguration of American Trans Air Inc (ATA) flights this month and Aeropostal flights next month, will compliment and strengthen a solid summer schedule. Pan Am's new San Juan service boosted month-end passenger numbers at Orlando Sanford. A total of 37,737 operations in May placed the airport 8% ahead of May 2000. The Airport also processed 940 tons of cargo during May.

Year-to-date numbers continue to remain impressive. With more than 420,000 passengers for the first five months of 2001, an increase of 20% over 2000, the airport is off to a great start as it enters its busiest travel season. A total of 299,144 international passengers and 121,851 domestic passengers have flown through Orlando Sanford in 2001, a respective 10% and 59% increase over last year.

Orlando Sanford International Airport is located near the Orlando attractions and is also very convenient to Daytona Beach. Adjacent to the airport are the business communities of Lake Mary and Heathrow, part of Florida's "High Tech Corridor." Airlines and their passengers enjoy free parking, new domestic terminal facilities, short walking distances, and low operating costs.
