**Caribbean Services Increase From Orlando Sanford**  
**New Flights to the Dominican Republic and Puerto Rico on Pan Am**

**Sanford, FL, May 23, 2003** – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) announces the start of service today to Aguadilla, Puerto Rico; tomorrow to Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic; and Sunday to Punta Cana, Dominican Republic. These flights, operated by Pan Am, will increase the airport’s number of Caribbean destinations to four. Pan Am began flying to San Juan, Puerto Rico in May 2001. San Juan has become Pan Am’s most successful destination from Orlando Sanford.
