Another Record Month at Orlando Sanford
Passenger Traffic Up 106% in April; Year-to-Date Up 133%

Sanford, FL, May 27, 2004 – Total passenger traffic at Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) for April 2004 was 157,191, up 106% compared to April 2003. It represents a new record for the month of April at the airport, breaking the previous record of 95,968, set in April 2002. The traffic mix for April 2004 was 81,155 domestic travelers, up 186%; and 76,036 international, up 59%. Specifically, there were 66,221 passengers from the United Kingdom, up 41% from April 2003. Cargo volume was up 12%, processing 675 tons during the month; while aircraft operations were down 12% to 30,472.

Year-to-date figures show an increase of 133% in total passenger traffic; with increases of 193% for domestic and 78% for international. Larry Dale, President of the Sanford Airport Authority, remarked; “These first four months of 2004 are the most successful in the history of the airport with over 439,000 passengers. As we head into our traditionally busy summer season we are well on our way to having a record year.”
