**April Passenger Traffic Down At Orlando Sanford  
April Total Traffic Down 37%; Domestic Down 48%; Int'l Down 26%**

Sanford, FL, May 24, 2005 – Total passenger traffic at Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) for April 2005 was 98,650, down 37% compared to April 2004. The traffic mix was 42,320 domestic travelers, down 48%; and 56,330 international, down 26%. Specifically, there were 46,865 United Kingdom passengers, down 29% from April 2004. Cargo volume was down 3%, processing 655 tons during the month; while aircraft operations were up 1% to 30,734.

The year-to-date figure of 366,698 represents a decrease of 16% in total passenger traffic; with a decrease of 35% for domestic, an increase of 12% for total international and a decrease of less than 1% for UK specific traffic.

Airports Council International (ACI) has ranked SFB as the fastest growing North American airport in 2004. Additionally, for airports with one million or more passengers, SFB is the 5<sup>th</sup> fastest growing airport in the world.
