December Traffic Up at Orlando Sanford

2006 Total Traffic Down Less than 1%; Domestic Up 13%; International Down 7%

Sanford, FL, January 25, 2007 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) saw 1,645,989 passengers through its gates in 2006, down less than 1% from 2005. The traffic mix for the year was 637,267 domestic passengers, up 13%; 1,005,146 international passengers, down 7%; and 3,576 transit passengers. Specifically, United Kingdom charter passenger traffic was down 11.5% with 862,227 passengers. Icelandair and flyglobespan carried 33,834 and 61,390 passengers during the year, respectively. Domestically, Allegiant Air saw tremendous growth over 391% over 2005. The airport processed 2% less tons of cargo with 8,297 tons, and total aircraft operations were down less than 1% with 319,050 operations.

December 2006 traffic was up 43% with 101,437 passengers compared to December 2005. The traffic mix for December 2006 was 63,980 domestic travelers, up 70%; and 37,061 international, up 12%. Specifically, there were 28,793 United Kingdom charter passengers, down 13% from December 2005. Icelandair and flyglobespan carried 4,198 and 3,753 passengers in December, respectively. Cargo volume was up 11.7%, processing 511 tons during the month; while aircraft operations were up 10% to 22,559.

Larry Dale, President of the Sanford Airport Authority, remarked, “While 2006 virtually mirrored 2005 in overall passenger traffic we are encouraged with the traffic mix. As we move into 2007 continued growth domestically from Allegiant Air and a full year of scheduled international service on Icelandair and flyglobespan should prove quite rewarding.”
