**December Traffic Up 13.7% at Orlando Sanford
2007 Total Traffic Up Over 8%; Domestic Up 32%; International Down 7%**

Sanford, FL, January 30, 2008– Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) saw 1,780,495 passengers through its gates in 2007, up 8.2% from 2006. The traffic mix for the year was 842,741 domestic passengers, up 32%; 929,469 international passengers, down 7%; and 8,285 transit passengers. Specifically, United Kingdom charter passenger traffic was down 7.7% with 796,018 passengers. Icelandair and flyglobespan carried 45,755 and 83,534 passengers during the year, respectively. Domestically, Allegiant Air saw a growth of 49% over 2006. The airport processed 9.6% less tons of cargo with 7,496 tons, and total aircraft operations were down 7.6% with 294,781 operations.

December 2007 traffic was up 13.7% with 115,397 passengers compared to December 2006. The traffic mix for December 2007 was 88,591 domestic travelers, up 32%; and 25,786 international, down 30%. Specifically, there were 19,374 United Kingdom charter passengers, down 32.7% from December 2006. Icelandair and flyglobespan carried 4,186 and 2,197 passengers in December, respectively. Cargo volume was down 41.6%, processing 298 tons during the month; while aircraft operations were down 17.7% to 18,573.
