Double Digit Growth Continues at Orlando Sanford

February Numbers Up 11%

Sanford, FL., April 3, 2002 – Passenger traffic at Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) for February 2002 grew by 11% as compared to February 2001. 60,223 passengers passed through the airport during the month. The traffic mix for February was 32,473 domestic passengers, up 55%; 26,360 international passengers, down 2%; and 1,390 transit passengers, down 79%. The airport processed 358 tons of cargo during the month. Aircraft operations were down 9% to 30,787.

“Our growth so far this year is due in large part to Pan Am and Vacation Express. Both have plans to add new destinations over the next few months.” said Larry Dale, President of the Sanford Airport Authority.” Larry Gouldthorpe, President of TBI Airport Management, Inc. also commented on the month’s performance “We continue to see our domestic and non-U.K. business propel the airport forward with positive growth. The U.K. visitor market still appears soft compared to last year and we expect that to be a factor in restricting our overall growth potential for 2002.”

Orlando Sanford International Airport is located near the Orlando attractions and is also convenient to Daytona Beach. Adjacent to the airport are the business communities of Lake Mary and Heathrow, part of Florida’s “High Tech Corridor.” Airlines and their passengers enjoy convenient parking, new terminal facilities, short walking distances, and low operating costs. The Airports Council International (ACI) ranked SFB as the fastest growing North American airport in 2000, among airports with one million or more annual passengers.
