Multiple Records Set at Orlando Sanford
Passenger Traffic Up 60% in July; Year-to-Date Up 85%

Sanford, FL, August 12, 2004 – Total passenger traffic at Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) for July 2004 was 278,524, up 60% compared to July 2003. It represents a new all-time record for any one month at the airport, shattering the previous record of 194,981, set last month. The traffic mix for July 2004 included a record month of domestic travelers with 106,679, up 83%; and a record number of international travelers with 171,845, up 48%. Specifically, there were 152,167 United Kingdom passengers, up 35% from July 2003. Cargo volume was up 1%, processing 887 tons during the month; while aircraft operations were down 13% to 32,178.

The year-to-date figure of 1,091,637 represents an increase of 85% in total passenger traffic; with increases of 145% for domestic, 50% for total international and 30% for UK specific traffic. Larry Dale, President of the Sanford Airport Authority, remarked, “This is by far the most successful year at Orlando Sanford, a testament to the strength and resolve of our industry, our airline partners, our partnership with TBI Airport Management and our community.”
