March Passenger Traffic Up At Orlando Sanford March Total Traffic Up Over 24%; First Quarter Total Traffic Up Over 25%

Sanford, FL, April 22, 2008 – Total passenger traffic at Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) for March 2008 was 171,631, up 24.5% compared to March 2007. The traffic mix was 130,594 domestic travelers, up 47%; and 39,627 international, down 16.4%. Specifically, there were 30,968 United Kingdom charter passengers, down 21% from March 2007. Icelandair and flyglobespan carried 4,724 and 3,935 passengers in March, respectively. Cargo volume was down 47.4%, processing 347 tons during the month; while aircraft operations were down 34.2% to 19,574.

The year-to-date figure of 406,172 represents an increase of 25.6% in total passenger traffic; with an increase of 53.6% for domestic, a decrease of 22% for total international and a decrease of 27.9% for United Kingdom charter traffic with 66,518 passengers. Year-to-date Icelandair and flyglobespan carried 13,866 and 8,357 passengers, respectively. Year-to-date cargo volume was down 45.3%, processing 865 tons during the month; while aircraft operations were down 26.6% to 57,502.
