Orlando Sanford Continues To Set Records
Passenger Traffic Up 66% in May; Year-to-Date Up 109%

Sanford, FL, June 10, 2004 – Total passenger traffic at Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) for May 2004 was 178,301, up 66% compared to May 2003. It represents a new record for the month of May at the airport, breaking the previous record of 114,009, set in May 2002. The traffic mix for May 2004 was 73,848 domestic travelers, up 178%; and 104,453 international, up 29%. Specifically, there were 87,368 passengers from the United Kingdom, up 9% from May 2003. Cargo volume was down 9%, processing 772 tons during the month; while aircraft operations were up 7% to 34,611.

Year-to-date figures show an increase of 109% in total passenger traffic, with increases of 190% for domestic and 56% for international. Larry Dale, President of the Sanford Airport Authority, remarked, “We’ve seen over 1.5 million passengers come through the airport over the past 12 months, the most over any 12-month period at the airport. This increase is supported largely by the 25 new destinations added during that period on TransMeridian, Southeast, Jetsgo and Vacation Express.”
