Pan Am Starts Orlando Sanford – Naples Service

Sanford, FL., April 24, 2002 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) announces the start of service today to Naples, FL on Pan Am. The service is operated by Pan Am affiliate carrier, Boston-Maine Airways using 19-seat J-31 turbo-prop aircraft. Two flights, one nonstop and one direct, will operate daily between Orlando Sanford and Naples except on Tuesdays. Flights depart Orlando Sanford at 1:00 PM and 6:00 PM and departures from Naples are at 8:30 AM and 2:30 PM.

Dave Fink, Pan Am's President, commented on the new intra-Florida service, "We have been planning this new Naples service for quite some time and we are looking forward to steadily increasing the Florida destinations we fly to from Orlando Sanford. The combination of the local market potential, connectivity of the Naples flight to Pan Am's 727 operation, and the ability to offer twin-center holidays to Orlando Sanford's British tour operators makes this new service very attractive to us."
