October Traffic at Orlando Sanford Reported down by 7.7%
Year-to-Date Traffic Remains Up by 3%

Sanford, FL, November 22, 2002 – Passenger traffic at Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) for October was down 7.7% compared to October 2001. The airport saw 118,560 passengers pass through its terminals during the month. The traffic mix for October was 19,222 domestic travelers, up 44.6%; 95,899 international, down 10%; and 3,439 transit passengers, down 58%. Cargo volume was down 14.7%, processing 1,226 tons during the month. Aircraft operations were down 10% to 31,541 from October 2001.

Year-to-date passenger numbers continue to surpass those for 2001, showing a 3% increase. Domestic traffic is up 52.8% for the year, while International traffic is down 4.9%.

For the second year in a row, the Airports Council International (ACI) ranked SFB as the fastest growing North American airport in 2001, among airports with one million or more annual passengers. Orlando Sanford International Airport is located near the Orlando attractions and is also convenient to Daytona Beach. Adjacent to the airport are the business communities of Lake Mary and Heathrow, part of Florida's "High Tech Corridor." Airlines and their passengers enjoy convenient parking, new terminal facilities, short walking distances, and low operating costs.
