**Viva Las Vegas!!! – TransMeridian Airlines Announces  
More Non-Stop Flights from Orlando Sanford**

**Sanford, FL, July 9, 2003** – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) announced today that on August 28, 2003, TransMeridian Airlines (TMA) will begin operating non-stop service to McCarran International Airport (LAS) in Las Vegas, Nevada. The flight marks the fifth destination served by TMA from Orlando Sanford. TransMeridian currently offers non-stop service to Syracuse, NY and San Juan, Puerto Rico, while Toledo, OH and Rockford, IL are slated to begin in August.

Flights will operate on Thursdays and Sundays using a 200-seat Boeing 757-200ER, which offers a 10-seat first-class cabin. The “red-eye” flight departs Las Vegas at 12:05 AM and arrives at Orlando Sanford at 7:15 AM. Service from Orlando Sanford to Las Vegas departs at 8:45 AM and arrives at 10:45 AM. TransMeridian's introductory one-way fare from Orlando Sanford to Las Vegas starts at just \$89\*. Travel at these rates must be completed by September 30<sup>th</sup>. One-way fares for travel after September 30<sup>th</sup>, will start at \$99\*. Passengers can upgrade to First Class for just \$75 each way based on availability.

All TMA tickets are nonrefundable. However, changes may be made for a fee. Travel on introductory fares must be completed by September 30, 2003. All TMA fares are net of taxes and passenger facility charges: \$3.00 per segment Federal Excise Tax (a segment is defined as one takeoff and one landing); up to \$10.00 September 11th Security Fee (per round trip); up to \$18.00 Airport Passenger Facility Charges (per round trip); up to \$26.80 on flights to/from San Juan, Puerto Rico in U.S. Transportation Taxes (per round trip). Note: The September 11th Security Fee will be suspended between 6/1/03 and 9/30/03. Fares, fare rules, routes, and schedules are subject to change without notice.
