Through Nov. 21, the Las-Vegas headquartered carrier will provide a \$50.00* one-way stand-by travel fare to/from Orlando Sanford International Airport from/to the following markets currently served by the carrier:

- Lansing, Mich.
- Peoria, Ill.
- Portsmouth, N.H. – Service starts 10/28/05
- South Bend, Ind. – Service starts 11/16/05

Impacted TransMeridian customers must contact Allegiant Air at 1-800-432-3810 prior to going to the airport. Passengers must have an existing reservation with TMA and present confirmation of payment for this reservation. This is considered a stand-by reservation only and customers will be placed on a list that will be confirmed the day of the flight, after all confirmed passengers have been accommodated.

*The \$50.00 fare is one-way and includes all fees and taxes. The normal \$5.00 per segment fee for reservations through an Allegiant Air call center will be waived. Fare rules, routes and schedules are subject to change without notice. Restrictions apply. Offer valid for travel through Nov. 21, 2005.
