Vacation Express Begins Service at Orlando Sanford

11 New Markets Served through Program

Sanford, FL — December 21, 2001 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) announced today the start of service with Vacation Express, the South's largest tour operator, linking six Eastern and Midwestern cities and five Caribbean destinations. Flights will operate Friday, Saturday, and Monday originating in the morning from Atlanta, Charlotte, Cincinnati, Louisville, Nashville, and Washington, D.C. bound for Orlando Sanford. These flights will arrive at SFB mid-morning to unload and load Orlando passengers, and allow other passengers to connect. After the aircraft are serviced at SFB, they will depart to Aruba, Cancun, Liberia (Costa Rica), Jamaica, and Punta Cana (Dominican Republic). Once the aircraft are serviced at these five Caribbean destinations, they will return to SFB in the early evening to unload, load, and connect passengers before continuing North again.

Orlando Sanford International Airport is located near the Orlando attractions and is also convenient to Daytona Beach. Adjacent to the airport are the business communities of Lake Mary and Heathrow, part of Florida's "High Tech Corridor." Airlines and their passengers enjoy convenient parking, new terminal facilities, short walking distances, and low operating costs.
