**Allegiant Air Begins Nonstop Service to Bangor, Maine from Orlando Sanford**

Sanford, FL, November 7, 2007 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and Allegiant Air, LLC announced the start today of scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service between Orlando Sanford and Bangor International Airport (BGR) in Maine. The Airport is located off of Interstate 95, less than 100 miles from Canada and 30 miles from the Atlantic coastline.

Service will operate twice weekly on Wednesday and Saturday. Flights will depart Orlando Sanford at 8:15 a.m. and arrive at Bangor at 11:25 a.m. Return service will depart Bangor at 12:00 p.m. and arrive in Orlando Sanford at 3:20 p.m. (all flight times are local). Allegiant will utilize 150-seat, MD-80 series jet aircraft on the route. Bangor is one of 27 nonstop destinations for Allegiant from Orlando Sanford.
