Orlando Sanford “Sprouts” New Nonstop Flights to Brussels, Belgium

Sanford, FL, March 6, 2008 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and Belgian airline, Jetairfly announced today nonstop, low-fare seasonal scheduled service beginning June 22, 2008 to Brussels Airport (BRU) in Belgium. This marks the first ever scheduled service between Orlando Sanford and Belgium. Brussels, the capital of Belgium, is the political and economic heart of Europe. Located in the historical center of Europe, Brussels is within two hours of other major European cities such as Paris, London and Amsterdam. Jetairfly is part of the World of TUI whose brand Thomsonfly has operated charters from the United Kingdom into Orlando Sanford for several years.

Service will operate weekly on Sundays through November 2, 2008 using a 262-seat Boeing 767-300ER aircraft configured with 63 Comfort Service and 199 Economy seats. Service is scheduled to leave Brussels at 11:00 a.m. and arrive at Orlando Sanford at 3:10 p.m. Flights will depart Orlando Sanford at 4:40 p.m. and arrive in Brussels at 7:40 a.m. the next day (flight times are local).
