**Allegiant Air Begins Nonstop Service to Wichita, Kansas from Orlando Sanford**

Sanford, FL, May 22, 2007 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and Allegiant Air, LLC announced the start today of scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service between Orlando Sanford and Mid-Continent Airport (ICT), in Wichita, Kansas. Situated in Southwest Wichita near many major roadways, including Interstate 35, the airport is ideally located to serve Southern Kansas and Northern Oklahoma.

Service will operate twice weekly on Tuesday and Saturday. Flights will depart Orlando Sanford at 7:15 a.m. and arrive at Wichita at 9:20 a.m. Flights will depart Wichita at 9:55 a.m. and arrive in Orlando Sanford at 1:00 p.m. (all flight times are local). Allegiant will utilize 150-seat, MD-80 series jet aircraft on the route.
