**Allegiant Air Begins Nonstop Service to Wilmington, North Carolina from Orlando Sanford**

**Sanford, FL, April 4, 2008** – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and Allegiant Air, LLC announced the start today of scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service between Orlando Sanford and Wilmington International Airport (ILM), in North Carolina. The airport is conveniently located off Interstate-40 less than 10 miles from the Coastal region of North Carolina and 80 miles from Myrtle Beach, South Carolina.

Service will operate twice weekly on Monday and Friday. Flights will depart Orlando Sanford at 11:55 a.m. and arrive at Wilmington at 1:25 p.m. Return service will depart Wilmington at 2:00 p.m. and arrive in Orlando Sanford at 3:30 p.m. (all flight times are local). Allegiant will utilize 150-seat, MD-80 series jet aircraft on the route.
