Allegiant Air Announces McAllen Service to Operate Year-Round from Orlando Sanford

Sanford, FL, September 11, 2008 – Allegiant Air and Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) announced today scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service to McAllen-Miller International Airport (MFE), in McAllen, Texas will operate year-round beginning November 20, 2008. The airport is situated in the Rio Grande Valley of Deep South Texas and Northeast Mexico. Allegiant Air inaugurated its convenient low-cost, nonstop seasonal service between McAllen and Orlando Sanford on June 7, 2006. Allegiant Air is offering special fares as low as \$79* each-way to celebrate the expanded service of the route.

Service will operate twice weekly on Thursday and Sunday. Flights will depart Orlando Sanford at 9:00 a.m. and arrive at McAllen at 10:40 a.m. Return service will depart McAllen at 11:20 a.m. and arrive in Orlando Sanford at 3:00 p.m. (all flight times are local). Allegiant will utilize 150-seat, MD-80 series jet aircraft on the route.

Allegiant's \$79* one-way introductory fare is limited, not available on all flights and must be purchased by October 1, 2008, for travel through February 5, 2009. Offer not available November 26 through December 1, 2008 and December 20, 2008 through January 5, 2009. After the introductory fare period, regular one-way fares on the route start as low as \$99* one-way. McAllen is one of 27 nonstop destinations for Allegiant from Orlando Sanford.
