Allegiant Air Begins Nonstop Service to Plattsburgh, New York from Orlando Sanford

Sanford, FL, February 1, 2008 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and Allegiant Air, LLC announced the start today of scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service between Orlando Sanford and Plattsburgh International Airport (PBG), in Upstate New York. Just one hour south of Montreal, the airport is conveniently located off New York's Interstate-87, on beautiful Lake Champlain serving as "Montreal's U.S. Airport". Service will operate twice weekly on Monday and Friday.
