Allegiant Air Begins Nonstop Service to Knoxville, Tennessee from Orlando Sanford

Sanford, FL, February 16, 2007 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and Allegiant Air, LLC announced the start today of scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service between Orlando Sanford and McGhee Tyson Airport (TYS), in Knoxville, Tennessee. Situated near the crossroads of three major interstates (I-75, I-40 and I-81) the airport is ideally located to serve Eastern Tennessee and Western North Carolina.

Service will operate four times weekly on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Flights will depart Knoxville at 7:45 a.m. and arrive at Orlando Sanford at 9:25 a.m. Flights will depart Orlando Sanford at 5:30 p.m. and arrive in Knoxville at 7:10 p.m. (all flight times are local). Allegiant will utilize 150-seat, MD-80 series jet aircraft on the route. Knoxville is one of 22 nonstop destinations for Allegiant from Orlando Sanford.
