I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for September were approved as submitted. George Speake nominated Andrew VanGaale as Vice President. This motion was second by Jack Taylor.

II. NOISE REPORT

+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public

George Speake presented the noise report for September. Mr. Speake stated that there were 25 noise complaints for the month of September. Mr. Speake stated that we had multiple complaints from Robert Kuybus who lives in Sanford. He stated that he called Mr. Kuybus back and let him know there was not much that could be done as his home is located on the final approach. Mr. Kuybus inquired about a buy out for his home but Mr. Speake explained that his home was not within the 65 dnl noise contour. Mr. Speake stated that the majority of the noise complaints that were given this month were due to a plane from the city that was spraying for mosquitoes.

Mr. Stark stated that Emery Riddle would like to have some aircraft come our way, use as we have plenty of capacity at this airport.
