**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for June and September were approved.

**II. NOISE REPORT**

**+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public**

George Speake presented the noise report for September. He stated that there were 12 complaints for the month of September. Mr. Speake stated that most of the complaints came from Mr. and Mrs. Wise from Heathrow. He stated that they are complaining that the planes are knocking out their satellite TV. Mr. Speake stated that he asked Ms. Staub to pull the report for one particular day where they complained of the satellite being knocked out. The plane was on an appropriate approach at 2000 ft. Mr. Kern asked in the room if anyone had heard of planes taking out satellite signals. No one had heard of it happening, but some agreed it might be possible. It was suggested that the Wise's should complain to their satellite company to see if they can fix the problem.
