**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Vice Chairman Michael Kern, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for October were not approved due to lack of a quorum.

**II. NOISE REPORT**

**+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public**

George Speake presented the noise report for October. Mr. Speake stated that there were 54 complaints for the month of November. Mr. Speake stated that most of the complaints came from Marilyn Hall and the Wises. Mr. Dale asked if the planes over Ms. Hall's property have reached an altitude of 2,000 ft. when passing over. Ms. Staub asked for a lat-long of Ms. Hall's area to be provided to her so that she may come up with a diagram to show what altitude the planes are when passing her house. Mr. Speake stated that Ms. Hall lives in a very quiet area; therefore noise she may hear becomes amplified. Mr. Kern stated that she lives in the center of the practice area for small planes coming from Deland, Deltona, and Sanford. Mr. Speake stated that the majority of Ms. Hall's complaints are on the big aircraft.
