I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for October and November were not approved due to lack of a quorum.

II. NOISE REPORT

George Speake presented the noise report for November. Mr. Speake stated that there were 30 complaints for the month of November. Mr. Speake stated that there were a number of repeat complainers. He suggested that because of the cooler weather the residents may have had their windows open and therefore the planes may have sounded louder to them. Mr. Speake asked if Mr. Matthews could provide him with an accurate map of the surrounding areas. Mr. Matthew agreed to.

Mr. Konstan suggested that Chairman Pennington could cancel two consecutive meetings and possibly meet quarterly. He also suggested that the meetings should be canceled the Tuesday before the scheduled meeting date if there is no one from the public attending or of there are no issues that need to be discussed.
