**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for October, November, and December were approved.

**II. NOISE REPORT**

**+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public**

George Speake presented the noise report for December and January. In December there were 32 complaints and in January there were 19 complaints.

Mr. Speake introduced Louis Howell who lives off of Gayle Place in Sanford. Mr. Speake stated that they had put noise-monitoring equipment at Mr. Howell's residence to collect data. The noise-monitoring equipment ran data for 4 days. Out of the 4 days of noise collection there was an average of 53.44 decibels of noise. Mr. Speake stated that the data collected was still bellow the 65 dnl mark.

Mr. Dale asked Mr. Howell if he sees the planes that pass over his home. Mr. Howell stated that three fourths of the time he could see them. Mr. Dale believes that the sound is coming from the take off thrust of the aircraft. Most of the aircraft that pass Mr. Howell's home are Allegiant Air flights. Mr. Dale stated that he would have someone speak to the chief pilot of Allegiant Airlines to try to modify the take offs to see if it alleviates the problem.
