I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:10 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. There being a quorum present.

Air Carrier-

George Moss reported that Pan Am will be working with an airline called Ready, Jet Go who has a contract with NASCAR flying 729 727 type aircraft.

II. NOISE REPORT

+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public

George Speake reported that last month there were only 7 complaints versus 39 complaints the previous month. Mr. Speake stated that 6 of the complaints were individual complaints and 1 complaint was repeated twice. Mr. Speake stated that 3 of those complaints were from Allegiant Air running engines at night on Runway 18-36 with the nose pointing north. He stated that the complaints were all from the south. He stated that he called all three individuals and left a message and that one person returned his call. Mr. Speake stated that he spoke to Allegiant Airlines and reminded them that they need to do their run-ups during the daytime or prior to late evening or early in the morning, whenever possible.
