**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Pennington. There being a quorum present. The Chairman read the mission statement.

**Review of January 11, 2000 minutes.**

**II. Orlando International Airport Overlay Zoning Plan**

David Konstan and Rick Alberts gave a presentation on how the Orlando International Airport implemented its Residential Overlay Zoning.

**III. NOISE REPORT**

Jack Dow presented the Noise Report for January, 2000. The summary of operations for the month of January and cumulative for the year are as follows: There were **24,764** operations for the month of January and **24,764** for the year, as compared to 1999 at **28,121** operations.

Domestic passengers for the month were **8,289** and **8,289** passengers for the year, as compared to January, 1999 at **2,702** passengers. The International passenger count was **33,000** for the month for a total of **33,000** for the year, as compared to 1999 with a total of **38,893**.

The amount of cargo handled for January was **560** tons. A total of **560** tons for the year, as compared to 1999 at **523** tons. There were **171** noise complaints for the month of **January**.

**Complaints by Time of Day are as follows:**

Day - between the hours of 0600 and 1900 - **22** complaints

Evening - between the hours of 1900 and 2200 - 2 complaints  
Night - between the hours of 2200 and 0600 - 2 complaints  
No time given - **145** complaints

Chairman Pennington welcomed Paul Belardo, of PAN AM, to the Noise Abatement Committee as airline representative.

#### **IV. Old Business**

##### **+ Part 150 Noise Study Presentation – Nick Nesta, HNTB**

Nick Nesta advised that the contours in the noise study report may be incorrect. If so, there will be changes to the report. The timeframe for completion of these corrections is undetermined. Therefore, the public meeting for the noise study presentation has not been scheduled.

##### **+ Update on Noise Reduction Ideas (Project 38)**

Issue papers #4, 6, and 8 were discussed and accepted as final papers.

#### **V. New Business**

Discussion regarding plans to establish an overlay zone in the local area of the Sanford Airport. A recommendation was made to take action on the overlay zoning plan.
