**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING**

*held at the ORLANDO SANFORD AIRPORT*

*Tuesday, May 13, 2008 - 9:00 a.m.*

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**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for February, March, and April were approved as submitted.

**II. NOISE REPORT**

**+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public**

George Speake presented the noise report for March and April. Mr. Speake stated that for the month of March there were 15 complaints but that nothing out of the ordinary stood out. Mr. Speake stated that in the month of April there were 59 complaints. Marylin Hall accounted for 42 of those complaints. Mr. Dale asked for a flight pattern to be obtained for Marylin Halls property. Mr. Speake stated that there were two odd complaints for the month of April. One complaint came from Orlando and the other complaint came from Sorrento.

Diane McCosker stated that she has planes that fly over her house off of the Tuscan subdivision. She states that planes make a sharp turn over her home and that they seem low. Ms. McCosker stated lately that she is seeing departures that are passing right over her house. Mr. Kern stated that this is due to the wind patterns and in the spring and fall the wind shifts but it is not a common occurrence. Mr. Kern explained that on days that you see a plane flying differently than what you are used to seeing, they are on a visual approach. A visual approach is used when it is a clear, nice day. Mr. Kern assured them that this procedure is standard and that it is done in a safe manner.

Ms. Linda Thomas stated that she could see the tires, gears, bolts, and could read the logo on the aircraft. Ms. Thomas asked what is an acceptable height for the planes to be at. Mr. Kern stated that when the planes pass over her home they are over approximately 1200ft.

Mr. Kern asked if we could have a representative come in from the City of Sanford on a regular basis. Mr. Dale stated that we have a member appointed but that he has not been attending the meetings. Mr. Dale stated that he would bring it up to the Board members to nominate a different person to represent the City of Sanford.

### **II. OLD BUSINESS-**

Mr. Speake stated that they are still working on the Noise Mapping Assistance from the Seminole County GIS. Mr. Matthews stated that he hopes to have this program ready by the end of the month. Mr. Speake stated that before this program starts running, it will be brought to the committee for review and input.

### **IV. NEW BUSINESS-**

Mr. Speake stated that there is a gentleman by the name of Jim McDonnell that lives on Beardall Avenue that has recently began complaining about noise. Mr. Speake stated that our noise monitoring equipment was taken to his home and the noise level was tested from April 17<sup>th</sup> to April 21<sup>st</sup>. The average noise level on his property was 51.06 DNL. Mr. Speake stated that his property is not in the 65 DNL range. Two-complaint letters from Mr. McDonnell were read during the meeting. It was stated that Mr. McDonnell would like the Airport to purchase his property. Mr. Dale stated that because his property does not fall with the 65 DNL contour, the Airport could not purchase his property with grant money and the Airport does not have a need for his property.
