MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
held at the ORLANDO SANFORD AIRPORT
ONE RED CLEVELAND BOULEVARD, LEVEL II CONFERENCE ROOM
Tuesday, May 15, 2001 - 9:00 a.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Pennington called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., after which he read the mission statement of the SANAC committee. There being a quorum present. The Chairman made clarification that this Committee only makes recommendations for noise s to the Authority Board. The Committee was requested to review the minutes of April 10, 2001.

Committee member Kern asked if a decision had been made as to how the Silver Lake noise complaints would be handled? Dow advised that it was requested that the times and dates be given when those complaints are reported. It was suggested that the Silver Lake noise complaints be treated differently as the regular noise complaints, so that the numbers reflect the community complaints as opposed to an individual complaint.

There were concerns regarding the Timacuan community noise complaint numbers, specifically those reported from James Edwards. Dow advised that Mr. Edwards is included in the collected data, and had reported 40 complaints for the month of April.

A resident from the Mud Lake area advised that she has logged complaints via the web site. The majority of her complaints are small aircraft landing and taking-off. There is no representation of her complaints by region. It is possible that an address is not attached to her complaints.

Kern advised that there is a cap on the altitude that Comair aircraft are allowed to fly. The altitude is between 1400 and 1500 ft. and is considered a very safe altitude. Dow will check the noise complaint database for Ms. Hall’s information.
