I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for May were approved as submitted.

George Speake presented the noise report for May. Mr. Speake stated that there were 11 noise complaints for the month of May. Most complaints came from the city of Sanford.

Mr. Dale stated that every year the Airport receives a grant for noise mitigation. This grant is use to purchase properties in the noise contour areas. He stated that he would like to see on a map of the location of where each noise complaint is coming from. He stated this would help determine if anyone is in the contour or 65 DNL range. Mr. Speake stated that with the new Noise Mapping Assistance program we would be able to determine exactly where each complaint is located.
