Dow advised that he has noticed Pan Am operating turn-ups on the north side of the terminal building and commends them for doing a great job.

**+Report on Field Trip to OIA .....Committee**

Dow reported that the field trip to OIA was worthwhile and included a great presentation by a Delta Captain who discussed climb procedures. Dow indicated that he was impressed with how well he and the SANAC Committee members were received by Orlando ANAC. He thanked David Konstan and Orlando ANAC for extending the invitation, and Bryce Courtney for the tour of the new air traffic control tower.

Vice Chairman Kern welcomed Heathrow resident Paul Walther to the meeting.

Dow advised that there are seven new airlines flying out of Sanford now with scheduled charters.

**Consideration for New Projects.....Dow**

The Part 150 Noise Study has been completed and submitted to FAA. Results from the Noise Study will be available during September or October. Capt. Rogers advised that Pan Am has made several recommendations regarding noise issues. The City of Sanford has proposed to Seminole County to jointly adopt all land use.
