**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for June and July were approved as submitted.

**II. NOISE REPORT**

**+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public**

George Speake presented the noise report for July. Mr. Speake stated that there were a total of 69 noise complaints for the month of July, 36 of, which came from Marilyn Hall. Mr. Speake stated that there was also new resident who gave quite a few complaints as well by the name of Jane Marsden, who resides in the city of Geneva. Mr. Speake stated that Ms. Marsden was on the approach/departure for Runway 9L/27R. Mr. Speake stated that DJ Staub has asked him to send her the collected data from Marilyn Hall's noise complaints so that she can give us a report of what aircraft have traveled in or near her residence. Mr. Pennington asked that the noise complaints for Ms. Marsden be included in the data going to be sent to DJ Staub.

**Air Carrier-** None

**General Aviation-** Mr. Wade stated that DCA currently has a low enrollment. He stated that he expects enrollment to increase in August and September. Once this has taken place DCA expects to resume flying on the weekends.

Mr. Dale stated that operations have dropped dramatically this year. He stated that a big portion of this is due to DCA. Mr. Wade stated that they are now using more simulators to train than they have been in the past 2 years. Mr. Wade stated that DCA is now conducting more training away from SFB, which obviously does not get recorded by the tower.

**FAA-** Mr. Stark stated that there has been discussion between the Sanford ATCT and the Orlando ATCT to change some items in the Letter of Agreement and how air traffic will be handled in and out of SFB. Mr. Stark stated that Letter would expand the air space to the East. Mr. Stark stated that this will push existing operations further east and that the operations to the west will be turning crosswind sooner than what the surrounding neighbors may be used to.

**II. OLD BUSINESS-** Mr. Speake stated that the Noise Mapping project that the county GIS Department is working on is almost done but has been put on hold because of a lack of staffing and budget issues with the county.

Mr. Dale stated, that for the record he had said that Mr. McDonalds home was not located in the 65 dnl range and therefore was not eligible for the Noise Mitigation Funding and that his home was not in an area being considered for any Airport construction projects.
