MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
held at the ORLANDO SANFORD AIRPORT

Tuesday, August 14, 2001 - 9:00 a.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Pennington called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. after which he read the mission statement of the Noise Abatement Committee. There being a quorum present. The Committee was requested to review the minutes of June 12, 2001.

Motion by Jack Dow, and seconded by David Johnson, to approve the minutes of the June 12, 2001 meeting. Motion carried.

II. NOISE REPORT

Jack Dow presented the Noise Report for June and July 2001. The summary of operations for the month of July and cumulative for the year is as follows:

Theodore Davis, Midway resident, commented on noise complaints from the Midway area and asked why the Midway community had not been placed on the noise map.

It was explained that since a sufficient number of complaints from the Midway area have not been received, there was no need to specifically track the complaints in that area. However, the airport is aware that noise does exist in the Midway area. Dow advised that the Midway community could be added to the noise complaint map.
