MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

Tuesday, September 18, 2007 - 9:00 a.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for June were not approved due to the lack of a quorum.

II. NOISE REPORT

+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public

George Speake presented the noise report for June, July, and August. Mr. Speake reported that for the month of June there were 91 complaints. Mr. Speake reported that in July there were 35 complaints. Mr. Speake stated that for the month of July he started receiving complaints from Lucy Gonzalez of Sanford. He stated that she complains about a plane leaving at 3 or 4 am and buzzing low over Sanford. He stated that his operations people say that they do not have a record of a plane leaving that early. He stated that the reason it is an issue is because it is a very loud engine that is being heard and that it is flying very low. Mr. Speake stated that Larry Dale hears the plane as well in his area. Mr. Speake stated that they are currently working on this issue. Mr. Konstan asked for Mr. Speake to call Vince Corbisierro to check on which carriers are out at that time. Mr. Konstan stated that these carriers potentially come from Orlando Executive Airport and are quit noisy. Mr. Speake reported that there were 40 complaints for the month of August but that nothing in particular stood out. Mr. Speake stated that for the month of July and August the outer marker was down for a portion of time and as a result some complaints were being generated around the area of the Seminole Town Center.

Public-

Mr. Buis stated that he is from Hollow Wood Lakes Community in Markham Woods and Lake Mary and that he is a pilot for SouthWest Airlines. He stated that he was representing himself and the homeowners association. Mr. Buis stated that the community is seeing large aircraft that are flying low. He stated that he would like for the aircraft to fly 5 to 10 miles away from their community, which would put the planes

over the Wekiva Forrest. Mr. Buis stated that the pilots are maneuvering over their neighborhood instead of the Wekiva Forrest. Mr. Wes stated that he would like Mr. Buis to continue collecting data and inform Mr. Speake of what is going on.

Air Carrier- None

General Aviation- Michael Kern reported that there are 28 cirrus planes on property. Mr. Kern stated that there is date of November 2, 2007 for the grand opening of the new building for DCA. Mr. Kern stated that about 2 to 3 flying simulators have come in. Mr. Kern stated that DCA is working with China and India to bring students here and train them properly in aviation.

FAA- Mr. Konstan asked how many days would Runway 9-R be closed. Mr. Speake stated it would be shut down for approximately 119 days.

IV. NEW BUSINESS- A report was done for Marilyn Hall of Osteen on June 22, 2007 to June 25, 2007 to test the noise level over her area. Mr. Blake stated that a piece of equipment was brought out to her house called a Larson Davis 820. This machine measures the sound level in the environment using one-minute increments. Mr. Blake reported that the sound level in her area measured 49.1 decibels for day/night sound levels. These sound levels were well bellow HUD requirements for action. According to HUD noise levels that measure bellow 65 decibels will not be taken into consideration for mitigation of noise.
